Intellectual Property

1. Participants affirm their submissions are their own original work, have not been copied from others or from previous designs, including their own, and do not violate the intellectual property rights of any other person or entity.
2. Submissions become the sole property of OBESSU and may be used for any OBESSU purposes, including, but not limited to, display on websites, flyers, posters, or other materials. OBESSU has the right to share the ownership of the logo with the European Union, as the co-funder of the EPiC project.
3. OBESSU shall have the right to adapt, edit, modify, or otherwise use the winning submission in part or in its entirety in whatever manner it deems appropriate.
4. If the winner is determined to have violated any rules, they won't be able to attend the final conference of the project nor will they be able to benefit from any of the other activities.
5. In case your proposal is not selected, OBESSU won't use it and you will be free to own it for your own purposes.
6. The participant assumes full legal responsibility in case of any infringement of copyright regulations and relieves OBESSU from any liability.
